

## Supervised Care for Preschool Children

With advance notice, we will provide care for children 6 months to 4 years of age. Babysitting is provided for the Evening Services during Erev Rosh Hashana (Wednesday, September 12, 2007) and Erev Yom Kippur (Friday, September 21, 2007) and during Morning Services on the first day of Rosh Hashana (Thursday, September 13, 2007) and on Yom Kippur (Saturday, September 22, 2007) at Holy Family Parish. At least one adult will be present to assure the safety and well being of the children.

In order to ensure that all children receive the best possible care, we ask that everyone adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Reservations must be made and paid for **no later than August 31<sup>st</sup>**. This is necessary in order to allow time to engage enough sitters per the number of children. *Any child who does not have a paid reservation by August 31<sup>st</sup> will not be admitted into the babysitting room.*
2. We reserve the right to cancel babysitting if there are not sufficient numbers of children signed up for the service. You will be notified before September 20 if babysitting is cancelled.
3. The cost per child will be \$10.00 for each service, paid in advance with the reservation. You may sign up your child for one to four services. We cannot accept children under 6 months of age.
4. Bring your child to the Babysitting Room (there will be signs on the wall) between 15-30 minutes before services start. This should allow you enough time to give any special instructions to the caregivers and still find seats for yourself in the Sanctuary.
5. If your child is in diapers, please bring all necessary supplies and write out any special instructions. If necessary, please bring a change of clothes.
6. If your child is **not walking**, please provide an infant seat, traveling playpen, or stroller.
7. Dress your child appropriately; rooms tend to be on the warm side.
8. We will provide some toys and activities, but, if your child has a favorite toy, blanket, etc., please bring it along. **MAKE SURE THAT YOUR NAME IS ON ALL ITEMS THAT YOU BRING.**
9. We will serve graham crackers and cups of apple juice. If this is a problem for your child, please let us know. If your child is not using a cup, please provide filled bottles and instructions. A refrigerator is available.
